The Learning Expert Teacher (LET) and Subject Expert Teacher (SET)

Grade 1 - 5

The Learning Expert Teacher (*LET*) or *Academic Coach* (Grade 5) is with your child *ALL day* and is responsible for *tracking* their overall progress.

- They work hand in hand with the Subject Expert Teacher (SET).
- Any questions/concerns about your child's progress, you should begin by emailing your LET/Academic Coach.
 - If you have a question that the SET is more equipped to answer,
 the LET/Academic Coach can always forward your email to them.

Any *questions/concerns*, you should email the *SET* or the *Dean*



Information for Grade 6 - 12 parents

Grade 6 - 8

Your child will study *Biology, Chemistry,* and *Physics*

Electives: Computer Science, Intro to Visual Arts, Intermediate Visual Arts, Mandarin Language & Culture, Choir, Band, Drama, Intro to Engineering and Computer Science, Academic English, etc.

They will take **BASIS** pre-comprehensive and comprehensive exams.

Grade 9 - 12

Your child will study *AP and Honors Courses*

Electives: AP Art (2D, 3D, Drawing), AP Psychology, Computer Science, Rock Band, Introduction to Business, Topics in Economics, Studio Art, Physical Education, etc.

They will take *AP Exams.*

The CJ is used in **all grade levels** to keep parents **updated**:


- Academic learning objectives







School IDs & Lanyards

All students/parents will be issued school lanyards and identification cards.

In-Person
