(Start May 2023)

Masks Policy

- Masks are optional for indoor and outdoor spaces within campus.
- Students must be wearing masks indoors if asked.

🕕 ATK Test

• ATK will no longer be required prior to entering the campus unless that person and/or particular classes have recently suffered Covid-19. In normal circumstances, we will not ask students, parents nor staff to undertake an ATK test until further notice.

- Vaccinations
 - All BASIS employees must be fully vaccinated and have had at least one booster shot.

🕽 Campus Access

• Parents or care-taker will be able to access public areas of campus. Parents will no longer be required ATK test.

Positive Cases

- Anyone who tests positive for Covid may return to the campus after 5 days of isolation. Before returning in these circumstances, the person must have a negative ATK test result with symptom-free. Any person who it would appear is attempting to re-enter the school before 5 days isolation must provide a medical certificate. Thereafter, she/he may return if the result of this test is negative.
- After 5 days of isolation if the ATK test still shows positive result, students are allowed to return school with a medical certificate
- Should the school see any outbreak/transmission within a class daily ATK testing shall be required for that particular week. School will communicate specific instructions to families in such a situation.
- Class remains as normal and disinfection will be executed at end of school day.

Symptoms & Illness

 If you or your child are unwell, please remain at home and monitor closely for symptoms of Covid.

Communication relating to Covid

• There will be community alerts to specific class. However, if we see an outbreak pattern, of course, we will take all necessary measures to mitigate the risk to our community.
